



Dear CKS Parents of students in grades 8th – 12th,

Included in this registration packet are materials for students who have completed 7th grade in our CKS Religious School and are enrolling in Kehi-Loft, our continuing education program for post b'nei mitzvah students. Kehi-Loft meets once a week throughout the school year and is modeled after adult-education classes.

Each week Kehi-Loft students will focus on one of the Kehi-Loft's four major components – expanding and deepening their exploration of Judaism and the world, socializing in a friendly welcoming group, community service within our CKS community, or developing into Shabbat service leaders.

Kehi-Loft students participate in a wide variety of events and discuss a variety of topics. This year students held a car wash fundraiser, assisted at the Purim carnival, set up the loft for the High Holy Days, helped erect the sukkah, and lent a hand at the congregation-wide yard sale. Discussions included a debate about health care, an exploration of the economy and its impact, and a look into how we view celebrities and honesty. Special presentations included a slide show and overview of Birthright Israel. Rabbi Susan assisted with the preparation of leading Shabbat services and I worked with the students on their d'var Torah skits and discussion questions. Once a month the students gathered in the loft to relax, listen to music, eat, and play games together. Next year promises to have more of the same plus new activities, special events, and discussion topics.

We realize that many students have busy schedules and can't attend once a week. The program is designed so that students can attend weekly or come and go as their schedules allow. In order to maximize each student's ability to participate in Kehi-Loft, we meet on alternating Wednesday and Sunday evenings from 6:00 – 8:00. Every session begins with an informal dinner with time to unwind and catch up with each other.

When our children enroll in Kehi-Loft, they are building an impressive record of service and study – one that colleges recognize as demonstrating continuity of interest and commitment. Your child can rise to a role of leadership and initiate projects in a supportive community.
