Attached, please find our 2011-2012 Registration Packet. Welcome to all of our new families and welcome back to those families who are re-enrolling! For families who may not be familiar with our Religious School, we are committed to teaching children a love of Judaism. Along with teaching the Hebrew language, our Religious School explores other aspects of Jewish culture (Israel, cooking, and history), arts (music, literature, art), and spirituality (prayers, Torah, ritual, and holidays). We believe Religious School should be both an educational and enjoyable experience. Grades K-7 meet each Sunday from 9am-noon. Our rabbi leads and teaches a portion of the Shabbat service every Sunday morning.

Students in grades 8-12 participate in Kehi-Loft, our program for post b'nei mitzvah students. KehiLoft has separate registration forms which can be found on our website.

Parents are welcome to visit our school at any time and are expected to sign up to volunteer throughout the year, either in the classroom, our school's office, or by helping put together a special event such as a Tu B'Shevat or Passover seder. On Sunday mornings, parents are encouraged to meet other congregants at our Bagel café or adult education classes while Religious School classes are in session.

## **SHABBAT MINYANAIRE PROGRAM**

As part of our Religious Education program students are expected to attend Shabbat worship services either on a Friday night or a Saturday morning. Attending services helps to reinforce the prayer curriculum in our school by allowing the children to practice what they are learning, as well as to join in as part of the Jewish community. We want our students to be comfortable in services and increase their appreciation for worship. Additionally, throughout the year various grades will be leading Shabbat services (dates to be announced). Please note, while attending services at other congregations is wonderful, it does not count towards the fulfillment of the Shabbat Minyanaires Program.

The minimum Shabbat Attendance Expectation is as follows:

7 <sup>th</sup>	8	Friday night or Saturday morning Must include at least <b><u>4 Saturday morning</u></b> services

All students must sign in when attending services to receive credit for being there. At the end of the school year, we will recognize all the students that fulfill the expectations of the Shabbat Minyanaires Program.

**Congregation Kehilat Shalom Religious School**  
**A Brit for 3<sup>rd</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> grades**

*Brit* is the Hebrew word for “covenant”. A covenant is a promise or a pledge. Our Jewish tradition teaches that the covenant God made with Abraham and Moses includes us as well. By fulfilling the covenant we become a people in partnership with God, and with our community.

Your religious school education is a covenant between you, your parents and your teachers. Please read this CKS Religious School Brit. Sign and return with your registration materials.

**THE STUDENT’S BRIT:**

- I will be the best student I can be.
- I will do the homework my teachers ask of me.
- I will come to class on time, prepared with my homework and necessary materials.
- I will treat my teachers, madrichim (teen teaching assistant) and classmates with honor, dignity, worth and respect.
- I will attend religious school, missing as few days as possible.
- I will participate in religious school activities, including attending Shabbat services.
- I will respect the building and customs of our synagogue.

**THE PARENT’S BRIT:**

- I will make the commitment that my child attends religious school.
- I understand that if my child misses too many religious school sessions I may need to hire a private tutor.
- I will make the commitment that my child attends all aspects of the religious school educational program, including attending Shabbat services.
- I will check for homework assignments and encourage their completion.
- I will encourage my child to read Hebrew at home on a regular basis.

- I will be enthusiastic about what I am teaching.
- I will be a role model who treats others with honor, dignity, worth and respect.
